

CONSTITUTION
OF
QUEEN'S PARK PRESCHOOL SOCIETY

- A. The name of the organization shall be the Queen's Park Preschool Society, referred to in the By-laws as the "Preschool".
- B. The Purposes of the Preschool are:
 - a. to provide by cooperative effort, an opportunity for Preschool children to participate in a program of educational play based upon their needs, interests and abilities so that each child may develop physically, emotionally, socially and intellectually; and
 - b. to better provide, by cooperative effort, an opportunity for parents to reach a better understanding of children's behavior and needs.
- C. The purposes of the Preschool shall be carried out without monetary gain for the Members, and any profitable accretions of the Preschool shall be used for promoting its purposes.
- D. The Preschool shall be operated in the lower hall of Centennial Lodge in Queen's Park, New Westminster, British Columbia, or at such alternative site of the Executive's choosing.
- E. The Preschool is a non-profit society, licensed pursuant to the *Community Care Facilities Act*, employing one or more supervisors approved by the Community Care Licensing Board, and owned and operated by the Members of the Preschool and whose program requires the orientation, regular participation and on-going education of the Members.
- F. The Preschool is a charitable society and acknowledges that all investments, including the income therefrom, is and will be held in trust pursuant to the Constitution and By-laws to further the objectives of the Preschool. In the event that the Preschool is liquidated or ceases to exist, all of its assets and funds shall be transferred to another society having objectives and purposes similar to those of the Preschool.
- G. Paragraphs C, F and G are unalterable provisions of the Constitution and By-laws.
